

ORDER OF THE PURPLE HEART

Created by General George Washington during the American Revolution, the Purple Heart is believed to be the first military decoration for bravery to be awarded in the American Army without respect to rank. Early in that war, awards were confined to the outstanding military leaders and Washington himself received the nation's first gold medal in appreciation for driving the British out of Boston in 1776. The Purple Heart (called the Badge of Military Merit) was established on Aug. 7, 1782. Notwithstanding Washington's injunction that the Badge of Military Merit be considered a permanent award, it was allowed to fall into disuse after three awards had been made.

On Feb. 22, 1932, the 200th Anniversary of Washington's birth, the War Department announced, "By order of the President of the United States, the Purple Heart established by General George Washington at Newburgh, New York . . . is hereby revived out of respect to his memory and military achievements." The modern Purple Heart, designed by Elizabeth Will, is awarded to all who receive wounds as a result of enemy action which necessitate treatment by a medical officer.

In addition to the men listed here as recipients of the Purple Heart, all men of the Regiment who were killed in action or who died of wounds, listed in the IN MEMORIAL section of this book, have been awarded the Purple Heart, posthumously.

The Purple Heart Medal is more than a ribbon or medal award which is worn on the military uniform. It is a symbol of sacrifices made and sufferings endured as part of the price of victory. Some of the Regiment's recipients of this honor never lived to receive their honors and many more have permanent scars as all too vivid reminders of the toll exacted for our victories. The trails of glory of the 123rd Infantry are blazoned with the heroic deeds of those who died and those wounded in action. In the Regiment 484 Purple Heart Medals were awarded—94 of them posthumously. Company A had the largest number of awards, 58. Company I had 54 and Company F, 50. In addition to the original awards, 17 men received an Oak Leaf Cluster for a second wound and 2 men received two clusters for two additional wounds.
