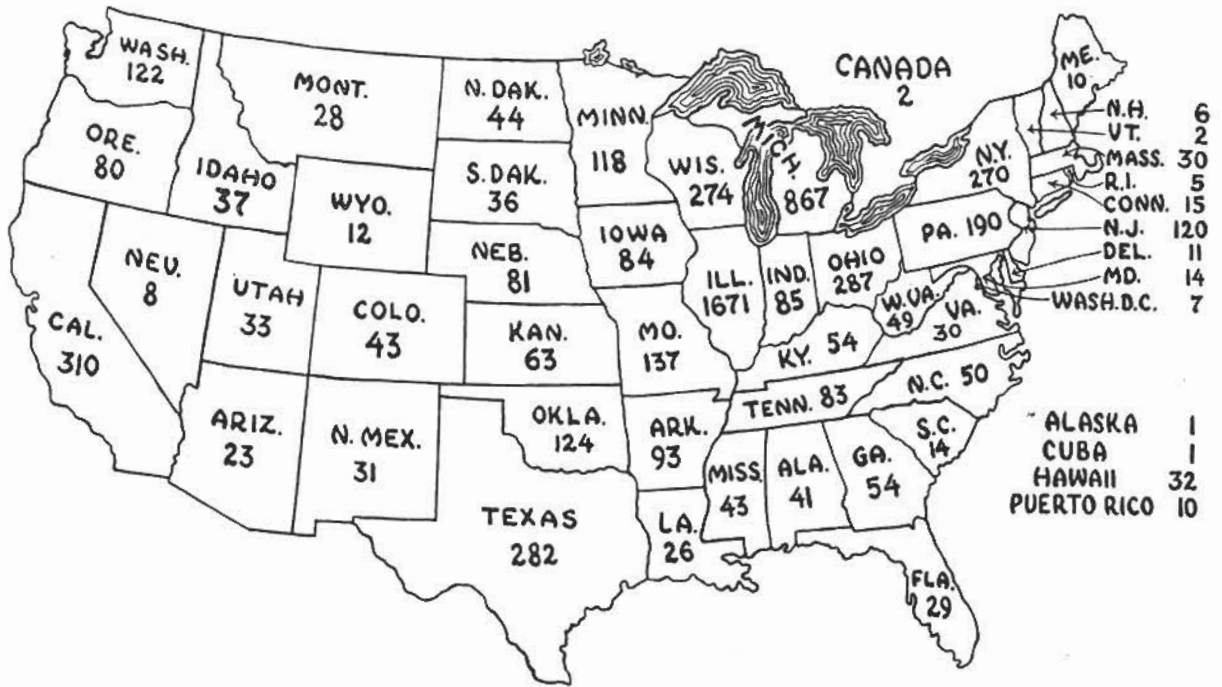


ROLL CALL BY STATES



MAP SHOWING NUMBER OF ENLISTED MEN FROM EACH STATE

The officers and men who served with the 123rd Infantry since its activation are a typical cross section of the United States. The men came from every state and from Canada, Cuba, Puerto Rico, Alaska and the Hawaiian Islands. As was to be expected, Illinois led with 1627 men coming from the Prairie State.

Officer personnel came from 41 states, Hawaii and Alaska. Illinois also had the most officers among the states. Chicago, with 526 enlisted men and 7 officers, led among the cities of the country. Detroit was second, New York City third and Philadelphia fourth. The tabulation by States is given in the following chart:
